Marsh of the maritime Risle with many willows, ash trees and poplars with a special cut, edges of Risle, fountain du Pré, paths in balcony with panoramas on the estuary, and the Risle Valley, authentic cider press. Follow

- Back to the gate of the church, go left of the war memorial and pass the stele of Father Rever. The presbytery park is worth a look before heading to the valley. To the right of the inn, go down to the marshes, passing the small fountain (follow the sign for the Lavoirs Route).
- At the bottom, after the purification station, take the dirt track to the left, then turn right towards the Risle that you follow to the right. Then, return to the village by turning twice on the right.
- A Turn left to go to the countryside and straight on the farm. At the tar, turn right to pass in front of the Fontaine du Pré.
- Follow the main road to the left for 100 meters, then go right to the Côte Macaire.
- At the top, continue straight on the path that overlooks the valley at the edge of the forest.
- Cross the road and go straight after visiting the cider press.
- At the top, cross straight and then turn right to go under the campsite.
- R Turn left at the water station to go back into the woods. At the top, turn right to continue along the valley.
- In the hamlet Julien, take the small road on the right then the first path on the right. Back on the tar turn left then take the path straight.
- Back on the tar, turn left then straight. At the crossroads, continue straight towards the Tison pit, then to the right to return to the village by a pretty hollow way.
